Who we are & what we do...

Chestnut Childrens' Events was formed in November 2006 and constituted in April 2007, by a voluntary management committee. Our team consists of local professionals trained in many different informal and community education disciplines. The group also consists of paid professionals, and volunteers.



All Workshops are carefully put together and designed to meet your needs

Our aim is to provide themed events and workshops complementing the 'Every Child Matters' initiative, for children and young people within Cumbria. Our workshops can also involve a mix of professionals from Chestnut and the local community according to the chosen event and booking requirements.

The individually designed workshops can involve educational games, active learning discussions, simulation sessions, art, music, craft, drama, individual learning, teamwork, evaluation and feedback. We can also provide fundraising events for your local community group by including your children.

How are we funded?

We are a non profit making community group. We are funded by schools, community groups, local grants, trusts and the local council. We can charge for activities on a hourly, half day, full day or weekly basis or we can assist you in applying for a grant.

How can I make a booking?

It's a simple as 1,2,3!

1. Download the booking form from our website or contact us for a copy and on completion post it back to us.
2. We will then contact you by phone to confirm availability and if necessary arrange for a personal visit by the team leader to discuss your requirements further. If you prefer, we can also deliver a short presentation to groups of children to introduce ourselves prior to a visit, to give you a 'taste' of what we do and who we are.
3. We will then provide you with the aims and objectives of the agreed sessions, a full timetable of the event, resources, and details of the planned activities.

We will evaluate with the children after the event and provide you with a simple questionnaire. During the visit we would like to take photographs as a record of the event for a display board or a dedicated area on our website (your permission will be sought for this).

What type of events do we offer?

We currently provide a set 'package' of events on a particular theme, within which there are a number of workshops. You can either book a complete package or an individual workshop delivered as many times as you like. We can also design tailor made events and workshops to suit your particular needs.
